They will each receive a \$2,000 scholarship for students interested in earning a bachelor's degree in math, science or engineering. The scholarship was open to one tenth-grade student from each of Utah's 207 high schools. The scholarship recipient from each school is then eligible for an additional scholarship. The grand prize scholarships are worth \$2,500, \$5,000 and \$25,000 and a laptop upon entering college.

"The long-term goal of the program is to help create the next generation of mathematicians, scientists and engineers for America's future," said Fraser Bullock, Chairman of the Foundation Board. "This is an excellent opportunity for the foundation to act locally and get results on a global scale. We recognize the need our nation has for a well-trained workforce, and this is a great vehicle to promote that."
