
West Valley students win scholarships from EnergySolutions

Laura Stoddard from Cyprus High School, Jeffery Crosby from Granger High School and Trevor Hightower from Hunter High School have all won EnergySolutions Foundation Scholarships.

They will receive a \$2,000 scholarship as students interested in earning a bachelor's degree in math, science, or engineering. The scholarship was open to one tenth-grade student from each of Utah's 207 high schools. The scholarship recipient from each school is then eligible for an additional scholarship. The grand prize scholarships are worth \$2,500, \$5,000 and \$25,000 and a laptop upon entering college.

In the initial year of the program, the Foundation received an impressive 1,032 scholarship applications from 118 high schools across Utah. In addition applications were also received from students in Georgia, South Caro-

"The long term goal of the program is to help create the next generation of mathematicians, scientists, and engineers for America's future," said Fraser Bullock, Chairman of the Foundation Board, in a prepared release. We recognize the need our nation has for a well trained work force and this is a great vehicle to promote that."
